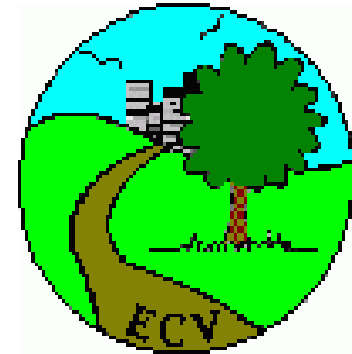

SEPTEMBER
