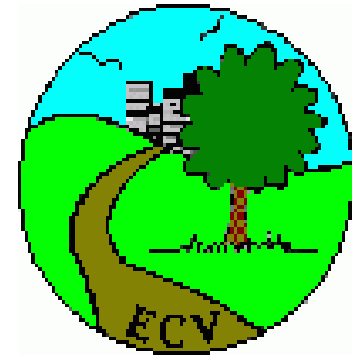

JANUARY

**Sunday 12 January
Mile and a Quarter**
